## Our current project

The Trust has built a library at Meetse A Bophelo School, the poorest of the four schools which it supports. This school of 2,500 pupils is located in the squatter camp area of Mamelodi. It has very few books and they were housed in a converted shack.



Below is the new library. It is a large, sturdy structure with a pitched roof, and a long verandah to give shade from sun and rain, **but it needs more books.**



Thanks to the generosity of many organisations and individuals we are on our way to filling the new library with books and equipment.

## On-going support for the project

The library project now needs on-going support. This will allow the headteacher and his staff:

- to replace worn equipment and books
- buy new books for pupils to use
- extend the range of books on offer as the literacy standards in the school improve
- provide further training in librarianship for members of staff
